## Pollination and beyond

High-school students Chelsea Connor and Will Fletcher-Hill worked on a comprehensive project to support the growth of honeybees. This work was done through the elective class Projects for Sustainable Living, and was submitted as part of a contest offered by Volvo and UNEP, United Nations Environmental Programme.

An extract from their report:  
"We are two students who were inspired by the beehive hosting of our school and the critical situation of honeybees. We outlined and carried out a comprehensive plan to support the healthy survival of honeybees that includes: leadership training to inspire others; environmental improvements (pollution re-

duction, composting, tree planting); community education and participation through talks, articles and a DOT campaign; increased number of beehive hosts; ensured perpetuity of the project by establishing a Green Action Student Team; took global action through fundraising for construction of two energy efficient stoves and a shelter in Uganda to reduce deforestation and fuel consumption."
