Camp, and wilderness survival instructor Ben Gallagher will teach participants to make rope and string from natural plant fibers. Learn lashing knots, friction knots, and stopper knots, great for making bow strings, fishing line and nets, basketry, jewelry, carrying straps, and

belts. Rope and string have many uses in the wilderness, and once learned, these skills will serve you in many areas of your life. Students will take home their own handmade string as well as a memorable afternoon with Ric and Ben. Cost is \$10.
